2023 Holiday Volunteer Opportunities

Our 2023 Turkey & Trimmings Collection Campaign will run from November 1 through December 30. This annual event is a fantastic volunteer opportunity for families, school groups and college clubs, civic organizations and scout troops! Whether you can give a few hours during the week or on the weekends, your participation will make a huge difference.

Volunteer Responsibilities:

Event Captain (requires approx. 4-6 hours per event)

At least 4 Volunteers will work with each Event Captain.

- Pick up all food drive materials from our Melville office
- Supervise and encourage the efforts of their volunteers
- Respond to inquiries about Island Harvest
- Coordinate collection and delivery of the collected food donations to either the Melville or Uniondale warehouse*

On-Site Volunteers (requires approx. 2-4 hours per event)

- Hand out Island Harvest informational fliers to shoppers
- Ask shoppers to donate a turkey, ham or chicken, a turkey coupon, or dry and canned goods
- Ask shoppers to purchase grocery gift cards or to make a monetary contribution
- Collect, organize and pack up all the donated food for delivery to either the Melville or Uniondale warehouse locations*
